As of December 31, 2022, The Foundation of Laguna Woods Village had assets of \$1,008,926 consisting of cash and invested Reserve funds and as of January 1, 2023 these assets included a Disaster Emergency Relief Reserve Fund in the amount of \$500,000 to cover expenses in the event of a catastrophic event. The assets are estimated to be sufficient to cover operational expenses for 2 - 3 years. During 2022 more than \$.92 of each dollar spent by The Foundation went directly to benefit residents of Laguna Woods Village.
